



Illinois Breast and Cervical Cancer Program Expansion

The Illinois Breast and Cervical Cancer Program is expanding to cover more women and save lives. Through this expansion, free breast cancer screenings are available to ALL uninsured Illinois women over age 40 and free cervical cancer screenings are available to ALL uninsured Illinois women over age 35. Additionally, younger symptomatic women may be eligible.

Whether diagnosed within the program **or outside**, treatment for breast and cervical cancer is available to Illinois residents through this program.
